Rugby Free Secondary School is an 11-18 fully inclusive school that opened in September 2016 with 150 pupils in year seven.

At our school we have a particular focus on STEMM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths and Music) Subjects.

Building rockets and robots and other exciting things encourages kids to become creative thinkers and problem solvers – and who knows what that might inspire them to do in the future?

We know that strong STEMM skills help with creative endeavours too, leading to better thought-out art, more powerful performances and more polished productions.
