



Rugby Free Secondary School Curriculum Sequence Overview 2023-24 HSC

Year 10 Link to Year 9:

- 1. Basic understanding oh human lifespan development established
- 2. Link to the impact of life events on health and wellbeing is established
- 3. Understanding NEA assessment criteria is established

Year 13 Link to Year 12:

- 1. Knowledge of theories lining to human lifespan development will be in more depth.
- 2. Solid knowledge and understanding on the jobs of people who work in HSC including their roles and responsibilities towards service users and other staff.
- Sound knowledge of key themes such as, advocacy, multi-disciplinary teams, empowerment, policies and procedures as well as inspections and regulations.

Year 12 Link to Year 11:

- Not all students will have studied HSC, but they will have an idea of human development, mental and physical health, diversity and equality – due to PSHE topics
- 2. Some students will have a sound knowledge of those who work in HSC and who they may help
- 3. Most students will understand the assessment requirements linking to a vocational course.

Year 11 Link to Year 10:

- Knowledge of those who work in HSC is developed and how they support people who use HSC settings
- 2. Feedback for NEA units is given and ability to act on and improve where needed
- 3. Understanding of exam structure is developed.
