Dear Parent/Guardian,

As you may have seen in the press and on TV, the government has raised national concerns around young people carrying weapons and knives.

As part of a national programme to educate young people around the impact of using weapons, and the consequences of committing such crime, a programme of work is being undertaken in partnership with Warwickshire Schools, Warwickshire County Council and Warwickshire Police.

This programme of work will go under the name Operation Impression.

Initially, this programme is taking place in schools and academies across the boroughs of North Warwickshire, Nuneaton and Bedworth, and Rugby. It is not being undertaken due to any specific concerns relating to Rugby Free Secondary School or Warwickshire in general. It is in response to national concerns around a rise in knife crime involving young people.

Rugby Free Secondary School is very supportive of these measures as it helps to safeguard young people and ensures a safe environment for all staff and visitors.
